



CAMP CHECKLIST FOR SUMMER 2020

1. Riders must wear a mask. All visitors/staff must wear a mask when in barn and distance is not possible (aisle, entrance, office, etc.)
2. Riders will need to wear skinny jeans, tights or breeches, socks that cover lower leg, English paddock boots (we have some to loan out), and helmets (we have some to loan out).
3. Arrival time is 8:30 until 9:00 a.m. first day of camp parents need to sign forms.
4. Lunch will either be outside or inside with distancing spots in place during inclement weather.
5. Campers will not have full access to the full barn area due to covid19.
6. Pick up time is 3:00. If someone other than parent is doing pick/up drop off please advise
7. Riders should bring a lunch that does not need to be refrigerated. We do have a water fountain to refill bottles and a vending machine. We encourage riders to take frequent water breaks through the summer.. the barn is a very hot place even in the NW!
8. We can't do a Friday parent show because of social distancing but we can take lots of photos of the riders during the week and send out to families 😊
9. We encourage riders to wash their hands upon arrival and upon leaving the facilities. We also have hand sanitizer stations throughout the barn and at the front door.
10. Our staff will be disinfecting the communal items used throughout the day.
11. Riders that ride throughout the year should have their own grooming supplies, boots, and crop to limit sharing. However beginner riders will be able to borrow grooming essentials which we will disinfect daily.

We will continue to have an amazing summer and have lots of fun in camp! We are taking all precautions necessary for covid19 and will make sure we help keep your riders as safe as possible in this difficult time. That said: we also are giving 100% credit/refund if the rules in our county make camp impossible or if you are at medical risk. Thank you
