Dear French Hill Farm and Stellar Sport Horses clients,

In an effort to help keep our staff and clients safe, we are sending out enhanced FHF Covid protocols that have been amended to account for an increase in indoor barn traffic during the fall and winter. Our purpose in amending these Covid protocols is to make sure that everyone feels comfortable and secure while at FHF.

Please read this email carefully, sharing the information with riders/parents as needed.

DURING YOUR VISIT

Masks and distancing are required.

Masks that fully cover your nose and mouth are required at all times while at FHF. You may drop down the mask while mounted, but your mask should be worn properly as soon as you dismount from your horse.

Sanitize your hands

Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer as soon as you enter the barn.

Practice Social Distancing

Please keep 6 feet away from other riders or staff at all times, including during lessons.

Only essential people are allowed in the barn.

Parents/guardians/drivers must stay in cars while their rider is in the barn unless their rider needs assistance getting ready. No visitors are allowed unless authorized prior to arrival. The FHF office and all viewing areas are closed.

Keep to your appointment/lesson time

Please be considerate and adhere to your appointment or lesson time. Arrive no more than 30 minutes prior to your assigned time. Depart within 30 minutes of dismounting. If more time is needed, please arrange with your instructor or trainer ahead of time.

WHEN NOT TO VISIT

If you can answer "Yes" to any of the following, **please do not come to FHF**:

-Do you have any signs of being sick including but not limited to the following:

Cough

Sneezing

Runny nose/congestion

Fever (we suggest checking your temperature before leaving home)

Loss of taste

Loss of smell

Sore throat

-Have you recently been tested for Covid and are awaiting test results?

-Have you tested positive for Covid and are still within the CDC quarantine timeframe?

-Have you recently been in close contact with anyone that has tested positive or is showing signs of covid symptoms and/or is waiting for test results?

Even if you are not feeling well, but do not believe it is Covid related, **please do not come to FHF** until your symptoms have subsided.

We truly appreciate everyone's cooperation with these protocols. With your help, we can continue to ensure that we will all be able to spend much needed time with our wonderful horses and friends!
